What is Sanatan Dharma...?



In the belief system of the mankind, first of all it is necessary to believe that the universe was created by some Supernatural Power and that Power is running it also. The same power has fixed everyone's Dharmas.

The word Dharma is mentioned in Rigveda which was used for created beings especially cosmic (like Sun) that they must follow the prescribed path. It was believed that if they did not follow that prescribed path, they would be responsible for many kinds of calamities and sufferings that will come.

Sanatan Dharma is the oldest religious philosophy, and it describes the values, duties and responsibilities that have been enshrined by the creator of the universe. They must be followed by everyone, living or non-living, even human beings. The Vedas, the scriptures of Sanatan Dharma, are the oldest written texts in the world, dating back to at least 7500 BC.

The word Dharma was used for human beings in their natural, religious, social and moral sphere that they have to follow the path of values, duties and responsibilities, rights, laws, character, virtues, right way of living, morality etc. Dharma is universal and it applies to all human beings.

Historical facts

Since 1,000 BCE, the emergence of various Sects and Faiths e.g., Judaism, Jainism, Buddhism, Christianity, Islam, Sikhism, Swaminarayan, Arya Samaj, Sai Baba, etc. started, which pushed Sanatan Dharma back. New Sects and Faiths used all kind of methods like force, coercion, allurements etc. to expand their base and followers.

The Sanatan Scripture "Maha Upanishad" depicts philosophy of "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" i.e., the World is One Family. This ideology prohibited the followers of Sanatan Dharma from expanding Sanatan Dharma through methods like conversion, invasion, war, violence, greed, coercion. Against this, the attack on Sanatan Dharma by other Sects and Faiths has been going on for 3,000 years. For this reason, most followers of Sanatan Dharma confined to the borders of India.

Despite all this, India has never invaded any country nor tried to convert the followers of other Sects and Faiths in any way.

Followers of Sanatan Dharma believe in living peacefully and they have shown the world that they are ready to live peacefully and in harmony with the followers of other Sects and Faiths. Hindus are the most tolerant people in the world and that is why nowadays Indians are respected everywhere in the world.

Recently Hindus have taken an aggressive posture and it can also take an ugly turn if the followers of other Sects and Faiths do not learn to recognize and respect the followers of Sanatan Dharma.



Why is the need for **SANATAN DHARMA HOLY CITY** (सनातन धर्म स्थल)

Sanatan Dharma is the basic philosophy of Hinduism. Sanatan Dharma lost itself in thousands of years due to the emergence of sects and Sects and Faiths (i.e., Jews, Zoroastrian, Jain, Buddhist, Christian, Islam, Swami-narayan, Arya Samaj, Sai Baba etc.). Resurgence of Sanatan Dharma is the need of the hour so that Hindus can be united and Sanatan knowledge can be transferred. This will be a milestone in character building and imbibing values and will save the Hindus from foreign Sects. Sanatan Dharma Holy City will play an important role for all these.

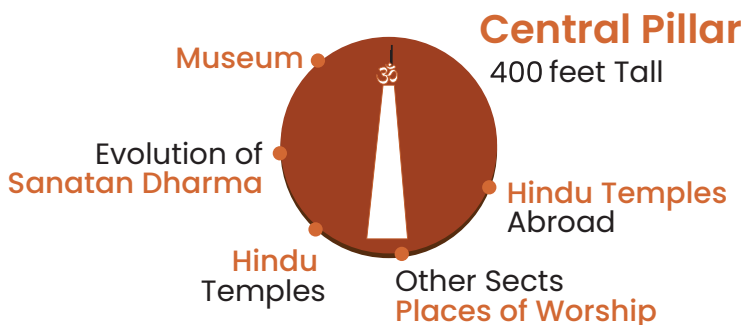

Funding shall be needed for following:

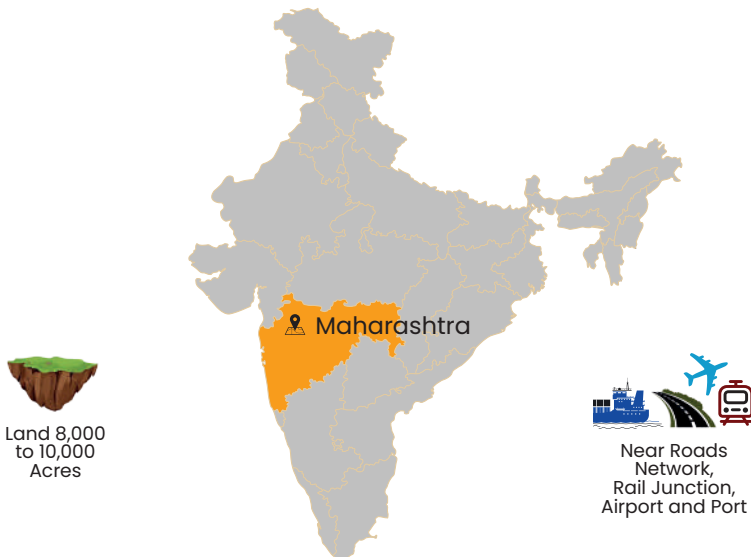
- To buy land

There are several avenues to collect funds and they shall be used according to needs.

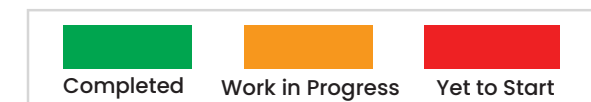
Main source of funding shall be from Hindus and Hindu Organizations.

5. Information on Vedas and Hindu Scriptures and basic knowledge.
6. Opportunity to worship & pray at all the Hindu temples of God & Goddesses at one place.
7. By circumambulation the Sanatan Dharma Pillars, the Pilgrims shall demonstrate their belief and allegiance to Sanatan Dharma.
8. Meditation at the Holy City shall give peace of mind.
9. Holy City shall depict magnanimity of Sanatan Dharma and how much it is spread all over the world.
10. Pilgrims after visiting the Holy City shall feel proud for being part of this civilization.
11. Pilgrims would like to visit the Holy City again and again.

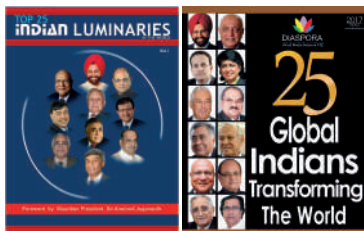
